I realized that a short description of the bids may help your initial review. As noted at the last hearing, there are second bids that were going to be completed. The second bids are provided in the document entitled supplemental second bid. The second bid that we obtained is identical to the first with respect to scope of work and items that need to be performed. My client then went through each bid item from the first and second and selected the lower bid amount for each item of work. In other words, when the supplemental second bid item of work was lower than the first, my client selected that. If the first bid was lower, then it selected that amount.

The document entitled approved bids is a summary and culmination of all the bid items, whether from the first or the second, that are approved and will be paid by my client. This document, for each item, shows whether the item of work came from the first bid or the second bid.
