Dear Mr. Cervantes: The undersigned firm has been contacted by Luches Hamilton. Mr. Hamilton informs me that he has been the victim of repeated illegal dumping at his rental property at 820 E. 5th St., St., Paul. Most recently, Mr. Hamilton informs me that his wife had called to report a number of bags of junk, child's car seat and a tire that had been dumped in the off street parking area behind their property. Mr. Hamilton received a citation from inspector James Hoffman to remove the dumped property. Mr. Hamilton contacted your office about this situation and was told that he needed to set up video surveillance to catch the person responsible in the act. Upon inspection of the dumped articles, Mr. Hamilton found checks and other paperwork that identified who may have dumped the items. Mr. Hamilton contends that if Inspector Hoffman had taken a moment to inspect the items he would have immediately discovered the paperwork.

Mr. Hamilton is very frustrated as the process the city takes in regards to illegally dumped items. Mr. Hamilton states that as soon as he removes dumped items from his off street parking area, more appear. Mr. Hamilton is a tax payer and is feeling victimized by the dumpers and harassed by the city inspectors.

Mr. Hamilton would like his tax dollars working for him instead of against him. Please contact Mr. Hamilton directly to discuss a solution for this situation.
