Your building was inspected on February 23, 2015 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

### A re-inspection will be made on March 16, 2015 at 10 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. INTERIOR BASEMENT NEC 110-26 Provide and maintain a minimum of 36 inches clearance in front of all electrical panels. Remove items stored in front of panel.
- 2. INTERIOR BASEMENT MFGC 602.1 Immediately discontinue and remove the unvented heating appliance. Portable heaters should have the tip over switch.
- 3. INTERIOR MAIN MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area. Provide a smoke detector in the bedroom.

- 4. INTERIOR UPPER LEVEL SPLC 34.13 (1) Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling height of 7 feet over 1/2 the floor area. Ceiling height in upper level measured 6ft 2 inches.
- 5. INTERIOR UPPER LEVEL MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturer's instructions. Provide a carbon monoxide detector on the upper level.
- 6. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 7. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
