calling 911 stating that she was being held against her will. The caller disconnected with 911 and when the operator called the number back, a female answered and then a male came on the line and eventually hung up the phone.

The responding officers were able to enter the apartment building and knock at the door to apartment # 4. Dispatch determined that this was the unit that the 911 call originated from based upon previous calls to the address. Officers knocked at the door for several minutes without anyone answering the door. They could hear at least one person inside the apartment and were concerned for the safety of the original 911 caller who they believed was still inside the apartment.

Dispatch updated the call stating that on call back the male who verbally identified himself as Lee Higgs told the operator that an unknown female used his phone and that they left southbound on Edgerton, on foot. I was in the immediate area that the male was describing and there was not anyone on foot that I could see at that time.

Sq. 322 (J. Pierce) contacted me and informed me of the situation and that he was concerned for the safety of the female that he believed was inside the apartment. I responded to the scene and we continued to knock at the door and announce loudly that we are the police and that we needed to come into the apartment. We still did not get any kind of acknowledgement from anyone inside the apartment. I attempted to get a master key for the apartment without success. At this point we had exhausted our options for contacting anyone in the apartment and it was necessary to force entry to ensure the safety of the person who called 911.

I made a final announcement stating that we were the police and it was their last chance to open the door, or we would be breaking it down. There was no response so I forced the door open with a mechanical breaching tool. We announced loudly "St. Paul Police" before entering the apartment and then cleared the apartment. Inside the apartment we located Lee Higgs and Rachel Aanenson. Higgs was uncooperative and attempting to argue with us. Aanenson indicated that she was the person who called 911 originally. See Original report. I requested a copy of the 911 audio and downloaded it to the media vault.

Officer Palmer photographed the scene and made arrangements to have the apartment door secured. Higgs was arrested for felony domestic assault and Aanenson was arrested for an active felony warrant. See original report and supplements.
