Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on February 23, 2015, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

A re-inspection will be made on March 23, 2015 at 1:15 PM or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior 1st floor SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) -Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.
- 2. Exterior Backyard SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.
- 3. Exterior Porch SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements. Repair the damaged porch.

- 4. Interior 1st floor entryway MSFC 1028.3 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.
- 5. Interior Entryway 1st and 2nd level SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. Patch the holes and/or cracks in the walls.
- 6. Interior Entryway. 1st and 2nd level SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. Paint the walls.
- 7. Interior Throughout SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
- 8. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 9. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
