Noise Source: USA Triathlon has applied for a sound level variance in order to provide amplified music and the use of a sound system for announcements from 5:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. on June 6, 2015 during the Duathlon National Championships. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) Variance will be for the hours of 5:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 6, 2015. 2) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers, or similar devices will only be located at the three (3) locations indicated on the venue diagram submitted as part of the sound level variance application. 3) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers, or similar devices will be aimed or located so they are facing away from residential use areas such as those across the river or the bluff area to the south. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers, or similar devices used in conjunction with the event must not exceed the following sound level limits: A) On June 6, 2015, between the hours of 5:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. must not exceed 75 dBA at 50 feet from the source. B) On June 6, 2015, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. sound levels must not exceed 85 dBA at 50 feet. 5) The applicant will provide personnel and equipment to provide continuous sound level monitoring to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 6) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers, or similar devices must be turned off no later than 3:00 p.m. on June 6, 2015.
