Your building was inspected on March 3, 2015 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on April 6, 2015 at 10:00 A.M..

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. BASEMENT - BATHROOM - SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) - Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code. CLEAN LOUVERS OF BASEMENT BATH EXHAUST FAN, DUST AND LINT BUILD-UP.

- 2. BASEMENT ELECTRICAL PANEL NEC 110-26 Provide and maintain a minimum of 36 inches clearance in front of all electrical panels. BASEMENT ELECTRICAL PANEL HAS ONLY 18 INCHES OF CLEARANCE FROM WALK-IN CLOSET.
- 3. BASEMENT LAUNDRY MSFC 901.6 Provide required annual maintenance of the fire extinguishers by a qualified person and tag the fire extinguishers with the date of service.-FOR THE SILVER FIRE EXTINGUISHER, TAG DATED 2001, HAVE THIS SERVICED.
- 4. INTERIOR MAIN LEVEL BEDROOMS SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window in good condition.-REPLACE THE CRACKED AND BROKEN HANDLES ON THE BEDROOM WINDOWS, ESPECIALLY THOSE USED FOR EGRESS.
- 5. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.






FLOORING- CARPET WALLS/EEILING-SHEETROCK 1656 CRAIG PLACE LOWER LEVEL LIVING AREA
