They denied my request for a variance because they don't want people exiting into their drive thru lane.

I have exits from the main floor going out the front (west) and rear (east) of my building that do comply as fire exits. The stairs coming down from the second floor have access to the main floor and the front and rear exits of my building.

I request that the front and rear exits of my building be considered sufficient emergency exits from my building.

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on April 6, 2015. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on or after June 1, 2015.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- EXTERIOR-SIDE EXIT MSFC 1028.2 Reliability, MSFC 1027.19 Common path of
 egress travel. Required exit accesses, exits or exit discharges shall be continuously
 maintained free from obstructions or impediments to full instant use in the case of fire or
 other emergency. Security devices affecting means of egress shall be subject to approval
 of the fire code official.
 - -Provide code compliant landing/steps on the exit discharge of the required exit for the upper level. This work must be done under permit by a qualified contractor. This must be completed by June 1, 2015.
