Procedural History

- March 23, 2015: Hawkins, Inc. submits complete application for conditional use permit (CUP)
- April 16, 2015: Planning Commission public hearing held before Zoning Committee
- April 24, 2015: Planning Commission approves CUP (unanimous)
- May 4, 2015: Appeal of Salina Amey et al submitted



Procedural History

- June 15, 2015: Minnesota Environmental
 Quality Board (EQB) finds petition for EAW
 valid, determines Minnesota Pollution Control
 Agency to be the Responsible Governmental
 Unit for responding to petition
- June 17, 2015: Public hearing held on appeal



Context: Why a CUP is Needed

- Hawkins, Inc. is proposing to add 8 additional tanks to their existing facility at 701 Barge Channel Road
- Flood protection is required due to location in the flood plain
- Where flood protection is not achieved by elevation on fill, the Zoning Code requires a conditional use permit
