NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Sound Level Variance – Groundswell Grounds and Sounds August 15, 2015

TO: Hamline Midway Coalition

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

Description of Variance:

Location: 1340-1342 Thomas Avenue Back Patio Area

Noise Source: Megan Greulich and Andrew Thoreen of Groundswell have requested a sound level variance in order to present live bands with speakers from 12:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 10:30 a.m. on August 15, 2015 at 1340-1342 Thomas Avenue. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) Variance will be for live bands with speakers for the hours from 12:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, August 15, 2015. 2) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices used in conjunction with the event must not exceed 85 dBA at 50 feet from the noise source from 12:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment who will provide sound level monitoring to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 15, 2015.
