Dear Licensee:

Your above referenced license(s) expired on 04/30/2015, due to your failure to submit the required proof of current liquor liability insurance. Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) records show your liquor liability insurance expired on 04/30/2015. If you are currently operating at this location, you are doing so without the required City license and proof of current insurance, and are subject to adverse action.

Effective today, the sale, service and/or consumption of all alcoholic beverages must be discontinued until you have completed the license renewal process by providing DSI with a Certificate of Insurance demonstrating proof of current liquor liability insurance coverage.

If you have not provided DSI with proof of current liquor liability insurance coverage by <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>June 23, 2015</u>, this matter will be referred to the City Attorney for adverse action.

Finally, you should be advised that if DSI determines there has been a lapse in the required liquor liability insurance coverage, you will be subject to adverse action.
