I urge you to vote for a 12% park dedication on August 12th. The parks and green space in St. Paul is why I chose to live and invest in St. Paul. The parks and trails are the best amenity our City offers to its citizens. It contributes to health, happiness and overall satisfaction of St. Paul residents.
