Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on July 23, 2015, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on August 24, 2015 at 1:00 pm or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. 604 Throughout SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.-
- 2. 606 Basement SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code.
- -There was a hard wired smoke detector that was hanging by the wiring, and there was an empty smoke detector bracket at the bottom of the stairs.
- 3. 606 Door to basement Door SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.-
- 4. 606 Kitchen SPLC 34.11, MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MSPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition.-The kitchen faucet was loose, and there was a leak in the drain caused by the opening for where the dish washer was connected.

- 5. 606 Kitchen by back door SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner. The floor is soft and sagging by the back patio door.
- 6. 606 Living room SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-
- 7. 606 Living room MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.-
- 8. 606 Second floor bathroom SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling and walls in an approved manner.
- 9. 606 Second floor bathroom MSBC -Section 105.1 Permits Required. Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building official and obtain the required permit. Work being done requires a permit. -A permit is required for the replacement of the faucet in the second floor bathroom.
- 10. 606 Second floor east bedroom Door SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.-The closet doors were off, and need to be reinstalled.
- 11. 606 Second floor west bedroom Ext. Door SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.-There were several holes in the door.
- 12. 606 THROUGHOUT SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) -Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.-REPLACE MISSING STORM WINDOWS AND SCREENS THROUGHOUT.
- 13. 606 Water heater SPLC 34.11 (5), 34.34 (2) Contact a licensed contractor to repair or replace the water heater. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Water heater was installed without a permit. Have a licensed contractor pull a permit and have the work inspected and approved.
- 14. 606 Kitchen MSFC 605.1- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.-
- 15. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
