SUBJECT: Summary of the public process and comments received on the proposal to incorporate bicycle facilities into the scheduled mill and overlay project on Western Avenue.

This memorandum presents a summary of the public process and comments received on the proposal to incorporate bicycle facilities into Public Works' scheduled mill and overlay of Western Avenue. The full text of all written statements received is attached to the end of this memorandum.

The proposal to implement bicycle facilities on Western Avenue was released publicly in July 2015. A website was created for the project, providing an overview of the planned improvements, data, project documents, visuals, timeline, and a project contact for questions and comments. Each project website was linked to on stpaul.gov/bikeprojects, a website providing a list of all bicycle projects throughout the city.

Notification was sent to the executive director of the District Council where the project was proposed (District 7 – Thomas-Dale/Frogtown), and an offer was extended for city staff to attend a district council meeting to present the proposed improvements. City staff presented the proposal for bicycle facilities on Western Avenue to the Frogtown Neighborhood Association Board on Tuesday, August 11, 2015.

Western Avenue Open House:

A community open house was held for the proposed bicycle facilities on Western Avenue and was facilitated by city staff. Residents and property owners within 250 feet of the proposed project were sent notifications of the open house via mail, along with an overview of the project details and impacts. 369 flyers were sent out for the Western Avenue open house. The flyers provided a map of the project, a link to the project website, contact information for city staff, and information about the project details.

Open House details:

- Western Avenue Open House Tuesday, August 11th from 6:00 to 8:00 PM, West Minnehaha Recreation Center
- A total of 14 people attended the Western Avenue Open House





Written Statements Received:

As of August 24, 2015, city staff received a total of 8 written statements specific to proposed bicycle facilities on Western Avenue from the following sources:

- Comment forms from the open house (6 statements)
- Statements received on Open Saint Paul (2 on-forum, and 0 off-forum statements)

It should be noted that the total number of statements received may include multiple statements from some individuals, as well as some duplicate statements (e.g. an individual may have provided written feedback at an Open House and provided feedback online on Open Saint Paul).

Next Steps:

The project will be presented to City Council on Wednesday, September 2, 2015. This will be a public hearing. An additional mailing was sent to notify residents and property owners of the City Council public hearing. 369 notifications were sent out. The City Council will be asked to approve a resolution authorizing Public Works to implement the proposed bicycle facilities on Western Avenue between Como Avenue and University Avenue.

I commuted on Western Ave daily for the past 5 years, year round. I think this is a critical north-south route in the city that should eventually connect many east-west routes. The street is wide and in some blocks won't even have parking taken away. It is necessary to reduce the convenience of some folks to park right in front of their destination or home in favor of removing some of the intense danger of currently riding in the street. I once saw a young girl trying to cross Western. On my bike I stopped for her to pass, as is the law. The cars coming down the street did not stop at all, and I felt like pulling my bicycle into the street to block traffic and let her cross. While the street does not necessarily have high volume, it could still be served by traffic calming (slowing), and I believe narrowing lanes and adding bicycle facilities will do that.

There is a serious lack of north-south through routes in this area. Dale and Rice are not comfortable places to ride. The City of Saint Paul Department of Public Works is hosting an informational open house on Tuesday, August 4th to present a proposal for bicycle lanes on Western Avenue from Como Avenue to University Avenue.

What is being Proposed?

The City is planning a street resurfacing on Western Avenue between Como and Thomas Avenues in fall 2015. The Bicycle Plan recommends bicycle lanes on Western within the project corridor. Implementing bicycle lanes as a component of the planned street resurfacing is proposed. To facilitate safe connections and eliminate a gap in bicycle facilities, extending bicycle lanes south to University beyond the boundaries of the street resurfacing is also proposed.

Changes to Parking and the Overnight Parking Ban

There is currently parking on both sides of Western within the project limits, though a sanitation ban limits overnight parking to one side of the street six days of the week. Between Como and Charles, parking removal is proposed for the west side of Western. Between Charles and University, existing parking will be maintained on both sides of the street. To simplify overnight parking for residents, limiting the overnight parking ban to Monday from 2 AM – 7 AM on the east side of the street is proposed within the project corridor. On the west side of the street, the overnight parking ban would be reduced to Tuesday from 2 AM – 7 AM between Charles and University. To measure parking demand, parking counts were performed at representative time periods on Western. Based on the data collected by Public Works, it is anticipated that parking supply following the implementation of bicycle lanes will be sufficient to meet existing demand. - City of Saint Paul staff will be available to answer questions and address concerns about the proposed plan.
- Comment forms will be available to provide feedback on the proposed plan.
- There will be no formal presentation the meeting is intended as an opportunity for the community to review the project and offer feedback that will inform the final design.







Project Details:

The City of Saint Paul is planning a street resurfacing on Western Avenue between Como Avenue and Thomas Avenue during the fall of 2015. The City is proposing to implement bicycle facilities on Western Avenue between Como Avenue and University Avenue as a component of this project.

To accommodate the installation of bicycle facilities, parking removal is proposed for the west side of Western Avenue between Como and Charles Avenues. Existing parking will be maintained on both sides of Western Avenue between Charles and University Avenues. Reducing the existing overnight parking ban to Monday from 2 AM – 7 AM on the east side of Western Avenue, and Tuesday from 2 AM – 7 AM on the west side of Western Avenue is also proposed within the project limits.

Project Updates:

A public open house was held on Tuesday, August 11 at the West Minnehaha Recreation Center to present information and receive feedback on the proposal for bicycle facilities on Western Avenue.
