Dear Mr. Whaley:

This is to confirm that our office has received your application for a variance from the city's noise ordinance and that it is being processed.

The Department of Safety and Inspections has recommended that a variance be issued to allow you to provide amplified music at a Concert at CHS Field, between 2:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check between 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 3, 2015. The recommendation is for a noise limit of 100 dBA as measured 100 feet from the sound mix.

A public hearing on your request for a variance has been scheduled for **September 16, 2015, 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.

You may wish to be present at this hearing to answer any questions that the City Council might have. After the public hearing, the Council may grant, deny, or modify the variance request.
