This is to confirm that our office has received your application for a variance for the Event Start on Shepard between Walnut and Chestnut and Event Finish on Shepard between Elm and Walnut from the city's noise ordinance and that it is being processed.

The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending that a variance be issued to you, with conditions, in order to present amplified music and the use of a sound system for announcements from 7:10 a.m. until 10:00 a.m., with a pre-event sound check at 7:05 a.m. on Thursday, November 26, 2015 at the Turkey Trot Saint Paul Event. The Event Start is proposed for Shepard Road between Walnut and Chestnut, and Event Finish on Shepard Road between Elm and Walnut.

A public hearing on your request for a variance has been scheduled for **Wednesday**, **October 7**, **2015**, **at 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.

You may wish to be present at this hearing to answer any questions that the City Council might have. After the public hearing, the Council may grant, deny, or modify the variance request.
