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NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Team Ortho Foundation – Monster Dash Lower Landing Park – Sound Level Variance

Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. <u>Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.</u>

Description of Variance:

Location: Lower Landing Park, by Warner Road and Hwy 52

Noise Source: Team Ortho Foundation has requested a sound level variance to provide the use of a sound system for announcements, amplified sound and DJ at Lower Landing Park, by Warner Road and Hwy 52 for the Monster Dash Post Race Event. The variance is requested for the hours of 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 8:45 a.m. on Saturday, October 31, 2015. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 8:45 a.m. for the Event on Saturday, October 31, 2015. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for music and/or announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment are shall be turned off no later than 12:00 p.m. on the date of the event.
