Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on September 16, 2015, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. The deadline for compliance or vacating the 'Maypop Tires' suite was September 16th, 2015 at 11:00 a.m. Required deficiencies were not completed by deadline and the suite is not re-certified for any occupancy. The suite must be immediately vacated and no continued business operation or occupancy is permitted until approved by DSI.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Maypop Tires Dryer MSMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. Dryer is vented incorrectly to the interior of the building.
- 2. Maypop Tires Near Front Entry Door MSFC 901.6 Provide required annual maintenance of the fire extinguishers by a qualified person and tag the fire extinguishers with the date of service. Fire extinguisher near front door has 2013 tags.

- 3. Maypop Tires Occupancy SPLC 40.06 The Fire Certificate of Occupancy for the Northeast portion of the building containing Maypop Tires is revoked for non-compliance. The deadline for compliance or vacating the suite was September 16th, 2015 at 11:00 a.m. Required deficiencies were not completed by deadline and the suite is not re-certified for any occupancy. The suite must be immediately vacated and no continued business operation or occupancy is permitted until approved by DSI.
- 4. Maypop Tires Office SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide approved permanent heat sources for the office per code. An extension for this item was granted through September 15, 2015 per appeal.
- 5. Maypop Tires Office MSFC 605.1 Remove unapproved exposed wiring and install in accordance with the electrical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Repair incorrect wiring connection at the newly installed water heater, currently wired with a flexible cord which is not secured at the appliance. Repair the exposed wiring connection at the furnace in lower level. Repair or remove the electric heater in office restroom which is incorrectly wired to a flexible cord.
- 6. Maypop Tires Office Near Furnace MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.- Remove or replace the damaged fluorescent light fixture with exposed wiring at ceiling in the office furnace room.
- 7. Maypop Tires Office Water Heater MFGC 501.2, MSFC 605.1 Provide, repair or replace the fuel equipment vent or vent liner to develop a positive flow adequate to convey all products of combustion to the outside. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090 Obtain inspection and approval for Electrical and Plumbing permits for new electric water heater in office.
- 8. Maypop Tires Storage MSFC 1010.1, 1004.3.1 Provide and maintain a minimum of 44 inch aisles where storage or fixtures are on two sides of the aisle.
- 9. Maypop Tires Storage MSFC 315.2 Provide and maintain orderly storage of materials.
- 10. Maypop Tires Vehicles MSFC 313.1 Fueled equipment, including but not limited to motorcycles, mopeds, lawn-care equipment and portable cooking equipment, shall not be stored, operated or repaired within a building except for buildings or rooms constructed for such use in accordance with building code requirements. Remove the fueled vehicles and equipment from the building.
- 11. Maypop Tires Vehicles MSFC 313.1 Fueled equipment, including but not limited to motorcycles, mopeds, lawn-care equipment and portable cooking equipment, shall not be stored, operated or repaired within a building except for buildings or rooms constructed for such use in accordance with building code requirements. Remove the fueled vehicles and equipment from the building.
