Attached is the smoke detector affidavit for 619 Pascal Street South, St. Paul.

Also attached is a bid to get the existing old fire alarm system functional. Below is the quote for monthly monitoring. I would prefer not to do this because of the initial cost and ongoing monitoring expense. We will have battery operated smoke and carbon monoxide detectors in place, which is the standard in most duplexes in the area. I asked this same question over the phone, but am asking again. Can I just go with the battery operated detectors, rather than updating an old hard wired fire alarm system? If the answer is still no, is there an appeal process for this type of thing?

The monthly monitoring is \$44.95 plus tax the contract is for 3 years and will renew for 1 year terms after the initial contract.

We would be installing a new main panel and cellular communicator in the basement replacing the 2 key pads(back door and upstairs). We would be replacing the 3 smoke detectors with new ones. The manufacturer recommends they be replaced every 7 years to ensure they are working properly. We would use the existing door contacts, siren, motions, heat detector, pull stations and bell upstairs. We will use the existing wiring unless we find that there is a issue with it.

When we original spoke you were getting false alarms from one or more of the smoke detectors by replacing them it should resolve that issue. We will test the whole system during installation and determine if there are any issues I may have over looked.
