NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on August 31, 2010.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. FRONT PORCH SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.
- 2. SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unfit for human habitation. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.

- 3. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 4. SPLC 34.11(4), 34.34(1) SPC 4715.0200A Provide an adequate water supply to all water closets, sinks, showers and tubs.
- 5. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 6. SPLC 33.05 Uncertified portions of the building must not be occupied until inspected and approved by this office.
- 7. SPLC 45.03 (6) Cut and maintain the grass/weeds less than 8 inches tall.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
