


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Inspiring Communities Update

- Standardize the HRA's disposition policy with clearly understood procedures and application process


Accomplishments to Date

• 391 properties (1-4 unit) total in our ISP-NSP-IC work

• 296 properties are underway or complete

- × 93 Underway construction, marketing, preparing to close
- × 203 Complete rehab, new construction or conveyance
- Result: housing unit, splinter parcel or vacant land sale
- 95 properties still to be addressed
