## Marcia,

I was just informed by my client that due to extensive fire damage it is highly unlikely that they will be rehabilitating the property. They are currently weighing their options on a demolition, but will not do anything until they are the owners of the property. The foreclosure sale is set for 1/7/16, subject to a 6-month redemption period. Since the borrower is deceased and his estate did not go through probate, we will be unable to shorten the redemption period (no successor/personal rep/heir to serve the Reduced Redemption pleadings on). Therefore my client will not hold title until 7/7/16.

My client also reserves the right to cancel the sheriff's sale, release their mortgage and essentially walk away from the property. I will advise you as soon as I receive any update from my client. It is understood that the city will move forward with its process in whatever manner it deems appropriate.
