- 6. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.-
- 7. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) -Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.-
- 8. MSMC 504.6- Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Dryer duct is not connected
