- Provide summary information of the fiscal impact of financial resolutions that come before the Mayor and City Council
- Provide accurate accounting information (codes, and amounts) so that budget amendments can be reflected in the Infor system.
- Resolutions and administrative orders without this information will not be approved by OFS, and will be returned to the resolution drafter.

#### Financial Analysis Template

- Provide the requested information in the <u>Financial Analysis Template (green tab)</u> of this file. Pop-up windows will appear throughout the file to provide more details on what information is required.
- Complete the **top section** (line #s 1-27) of the Financial Analysis Template for any finance related resolutions, including:
  - Grants: applying for, accepting, and budgeting
  - Donations: soliciting, accepting, and budgeting
  - Budget amendments: both resolutions and administrative orders
- All other resolutions with a financial impact
- Required fields are marked with red font or borders.

### • General Ledger (GL) - Annual Budget

- Complete the General Ledger section for all changes to the annual budget
- Provide accurate **GL account codes**: Company, Accounting Unit (fund-department-cost center), Account
- If you need help with GL codes, check the Chart of Accounts crosswalk on the intranet or contact Lori Lee x68822
- This section is required for all changes to the budget via budget amendment or administrative order

### • Activity Ledger (AC) - Life to Date Activity Budget

- Complete the Activity Ledger section in addition to the GL section for changes to the following budgets:
  - Grants
  - Capital and Capital Bond Proceeds
  - STAR
  - TIF
  - HRA
- Provide accurate **AC account codes**: Activity Group, Activity, Account Category
