Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.-Parking space at rear of lot is gravel.

- 2. Exterior Retaining Wall-East Side SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Retaining wall to the east is deteriorating, large pieces missing.
- 3. Interior Furnace Electrical Box MSFC 605.6 Provide all electrical splices within junction boxes.-At furnace, one furnace has enclosed electrical, one is missing the enclosure.
- 4. Interior Lower Unit Bathroom SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Bathroom ceiling has peeling paint and discoloration from humidity.
- 5. Interior Upper Unit MSFC 1028.3 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exit way.- At sleeping room emergency escape window and aisle leading to it At entry, door does not open completely.
- 6. Interior Upper Unit MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials.Reduce the amount of combustibles in the unit by 50%. This includes clothing, storage containers.
