It has been brought to our attention that our neighbors John and Lee Mannillo, 1335 Beechwood Place, St. Paul, have received a recent letter from the city notifying them of a complaint about their property. The letter indicates that their pool area is not properly fenced on its Beechwood side.

As their neighbors immediately north of and closest to the pool area, we believe the existing fence on their property to be well constructed, well maintained, attractive and safe. The Beechwood side of the pool is fenced with a tall, thick hedge and a gate. John and Lee have been our neighbors for 37 years, and the area has been landscaped in this way since the pool's construction many years ago.

The Mannillos are excellent neighbors of good character, public service and high integrity. If the area's current landscaping meets the standards required by their insurance carrier, we see no reason why it does not meet the city's standards. A fence on the Beechwood side would deter from the aesthetics of the Mannillos' property and the property of their neighbors. We would support the granting the Mannillos a variance from compliance with the city's statute for this reason.

We want to be perfectly clear that we are friends of the Mannillos and did not file any kind of concern or complaint about their property.
