Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

RE: 740 STEWART AVE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on January 21, 2016, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on a future date set by the Legislative Hearing Officer or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Rear SPLC 65.141 (g) There shall be no exterior storage of equipment, supplies or commercial vehicles associated with the home occupation, nor parking of more than one (1) business car, pickup truck or small van, nor any additional vehicles except those for permitted employees identified under paragraph (d).
- -Remove all business equipment including wood pallets, pump jacks, siding materials, ladders, planks and stored rain gutters.
- 2. Exterior Rear SPLC 34.08 (6), 34.31 (4) Remove the accumulation of exterior storage that creates a nuisance or harbors rodents.-Remove all pallets, construction material and work equipment from the property.
- 3. Rear SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-8989.

- 4. Unit 4 MSFC 703 Provide, repair or replace the fire rated door and assembly. -Repair and maintain the door closer.
- 5. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 6. MSFC 304.3.3 Relocate dumpster at least 5 feet away from combustible walls, openings, or combustible eaves and overhangs.
- 7. MSFC 901.6 Provide required annual maintenance of the fire extinguishers by a qualified person and tag the fire extinguishers with the date of service.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
