**11. Describe the steps that will be taken to minimize the noise levels**

Visit Saint Paul is very cognizant of the neighbors near the event location including those in Irvine Park and Irvine Park Towers as well as residents off of Chestnut Street near Cossetta's. We would like to work closely with DSI to get some accurate measurements of the sound these events produce – not in the tents, but near the residential neighborhood. We will utilize a decibel reader and do some readings throughout the day and evening. As the organization with the name on the sound variance for the full event, Visit Saint Paul will be sure all entities are aware of sound level restrictions.

**12. Briefly state reason for seeking variance:**

We are seeking this variance in conjunction with the LuckyPalooza on West 7<sup>th</sup> event – one of the many events that make Saint Paul the St. Patrick’s Day headquarters in the upper Midwest. We are seeking the variance to play music from six locations (three outdoors, three in a tent from 2-10:30pm and then three in the tents until midnight.)
