The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **February 19, 2016** and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code¹ (see footnote 1, below).

- 1. Storm water is being conducted through the fence and off property via downspout. Discontinue directing storm water onto alley right-of-way.
- 2. Wood fence near alley is severely listing. Repair/replace/remove fence. (Completion date for this item is 05/01/16.)
- 3. Garage "lean to" addition is not secure from entry. Install locking door on alley side.
- 4. City Code only allows two accessory buildings in addition to the garage. There are also square-feet of lot coverage limitations. There are a total of five accessory building on site. Excessive buildings must be removed. You may decide to replace these smaller sheds/buildings with a larger shed. Sheds of 200 SF or less typically do not require a permit. (Completion date for this item is 05/01/16, unless further deterioration of these accessory structures occurs before then.)

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will reinspect these premises on or after February 29, 2016, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges² and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk at 651-266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal, and pay a filing fee.)
