

Description of Variance:

Location: Rice Park and Landmark Plaza

Noise Source: Ordway Center Flint Hills International Children's Festival 2016 has requested a sound level variance in order to present live bands at Rice Park and Landmark Plaza with a requested sound level limit of 90-100 decibels (dBA) at 50 feet beginning May 31, 2016 through June 3, 2016, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 9:30 a.m. on May 31, 2016, and June 4 and 5, 2016 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the Ordway Center Flint Hills International Children's Festival 2016 at Rice Park and Landmark Plaza from May 31, 2015 through June 3, 2016, with a pre-event sound check at 9:30 a.m. on May 31, 2016. 2) Noise source of operation for the event performances are 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. from May 31, 2016 through June 3, 2016 and 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on June 4 and 5, 2016. 3) All electronically powered equipment, PA system, loudspeaker or any similar device used in conjunction with the event, will not exceed 90 dBA, as measured 50 feet from any stage or sound source used for music and/or announcements between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. 4). The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 5). All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices will be turned off by 2:00 p.m. on May 31 through June 3, 2016 and by 5:00 p.m. on June 4 and 5, 2016.
