Your building was inspected on February 22, 2016, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A re-inspection will be made on or after March 22, 2016 or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

- 2. Exterior Rear Fire Exit Stairway SPLC 34.32(2), MSFC 1027.23 Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks or railings in an approved manner. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. Replace unsound exterior stairway in an approved manner. Guardrails, decking and supports have significant deterioration and stairway is not supported in an approved manner. This stairway is a required 2nd exit from the 2nd floor assembly hall.
- 3. Exterior Rear Fire Exit Stairway MSFC 1028.3 The means of egress must be kept free from obstructions that would prevent its use, including the accumulation of snow and

Attached please find a copy of the Application for Appeal for the above subject. We are considering two possible approaches bring our situation into compliance.
