HMONGTOWN FESTIVAL SUMMARY

June 25 & 26, 2016

Festival Applicant

The HmongTown Festival (HTF) is a festival hosted by the HmongTown Marketplace, LLC. The HmongTown Marketplace has been existed at 217 Como Ave since 2004. It is a bazaar marketplace providing over 200 all year-round in-door spaces and over 100 out-door (summer only) spaces for the Hmong Community to do businesses. The marketplace opens 7 days a week and 365 days/year.

Purpose

The HmongTown Marketplace has been existed for over 12 years. In the past years it has been holding small celebrations within the marketplace. Many travelers and people from the neighborhood have been giving us feedback that they do not know the existence of the marketplace. This year we plan to expand the activity outside the marketplace onto Como Ave and the Schefer Park. The purpose is to increase awareness of our existence, to bring people back to the neighborhood and to expose the Hmong culture to the communities at large.

Festival Location

HmongTown Festival will be held inside the HmongTown Marketplace, Como Ave and the Schefer Park (across street from the marketplace). Como Ave (from Marion Street to Galtier Street) will be closed for the two days event.

Festival Activities

The activities of the festival will include the followings:

- Food and drinks booths (these are not including the existing indoor food booths)
- Liquor sale booth
- General merchandise sales
- Live music on stage
- Kids rides
- Parade



The food booths and general merchandise booths are planned to set on Como Ave and the HmongTown Marketplace parking lot where the music, children rides and other activities are held inside the Schefer Park.

There will be a parade involved and the parade is planned to circle around the Schefer Park. The staging will be inside the HmongTown Marketplace, exiting from the marketplace out to Como Ave, turning right and at Galtier Street, turning left to Thomas Ave, left to Marion Street, left to Como and then back into the marketplace.
