## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. Basement UMC 1346.703 Provide 30 inches clearance around all mechanical equipment.-Provide clearance around furnace, water heater, water meter, and electrical panel.
- 2. Garage SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. **Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.**
- 3. Upstairs Bathroom SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.
- 4. Upstairs Hallway MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monovide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.-CO alarm was present but not working properly.

5. SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d - Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.
