Your building was inspected on April 21, 2016 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

**A re-inspection will be made on May 25, 2016 at 2:00pm.**

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

**YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.**

#### DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Exterior - SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c; 34.33 (1) b, c - Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. Scrape and paint chipped and peeling areas of home and shed.
2. Exterior - SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) - All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements. Clean out gutters on dwelling.
3. Interior - Basement - MSBC -Section 105.1 - Permits Required. Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by this code.

or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building department to obtain the required permit. Work being done requires a permit. Have a licensed contractor install permit and have it finalized for water heater installed in 2015.

4. Interior - Basement - NEC 110.26 - Provide and maintain a minimum of 36 inches clearance in front of all electrical panels.

5. Interior - Basement - MSMEC 504.6 - Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. Bring dryer vent to code.

6. Interior - Basement Bathroom - SPLC 34.14 (3), MPC 4715.200.T - Provide and maintain a window or approved ventilation system in all bathrooms.

7. Interior - SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) - Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. - Repair damaged walls.

8. Interior - SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) - Repair or replace and maintain the woodwork in an approved manner. Replace door that was off hinges.

9. Interior - SPLC 34.09 (3) i - Provide and maintain an approved one-inch throw single cylinder deadbolt lock. Provide deadbolt for interior door to garage and rear door.

Hi Mr. Klein

I received your message and letter regarding an appointment to inspect my house at 21 Warren Street. The appointment is set for April 7 at 1:30 pm. Unfortunately I will be in Arizona and am not sure my daughter Jessica Moore Harjo is available to meet with you that date. She is a doctoral student and graduate instructor at U of M and works part time at the American Indian Cancer Foundation in Minneapolis. Her husband Russel Harjo also lives in our house and works fulltime the past several years at Thomson Reuters as a software engineer.

You asked if I live in my house. I live there part time and have always kept up my own room and the house, even though I also live part time in Oklahoma during the winter to take care of my elderly mother. My daughter, who was raised in the house at 21 Warren, has lived there fulltime since 2011. We both maintain the house. I work part time with the Shakopee Mdewakanton Dakota Tribal Court in Prior Lake as a Pro Tem Judge. I had a roommate in my house for a few years prior to 2011 while I worked as a part time judge at the Prairie Island Dakota tribe.

Our house is not a rental unit but has always been our residence. I have always paid the utilities and taxes and insurance since 1995 when I bought it. So I don't understand why this Fire Safety Inspection would be required. ???

But if it is required for some reason, it should pass all the items on the checklist. We are having our smoke alarm system and CO monitors scheduled to be checked or renewed in april.
