### **Description of Variance**

**Location:** 377 University Avenue West, Western Avenue between Aurora and Sherburne Avenues, 422 University Avenue

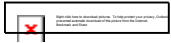
**Noise Source:** The Asian Economic Development Association has applied for a sound level variance, at a requested sound level limit of 90 decibels (dBA) at a distance of 50 feet from any stage or sound source, in order to present various activities such as amplified music, performances, and announcements, on three outdoor stages, located at 377 University Ave West, Western Avenue between Aurora and Sherburne Avenues and at 422 University Avenue West for the Little Mekong Night Market on Saturday, July 23, 2016 from 5:00 p.m. until Midnight and on Sunday, July 24, 2016 from 5:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 12:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance will be for the Little Mekong Night Market on three outdoor stages located at 377 University Ave West, Western Avenue between Aurora and Sherburne Avenues, and at 422 University Avenue West on Saturday, July 23, 2016 from 5:00 p.m. to midnight and on Sunday, July 24, 2016 from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from noon to 5:00 p.m. 2) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices used in conjunction with the event must not exceed 80 dBA as measured 50 feet from any stage or sound source from 12:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. on July 23 and July 24, 2016; must not exceed 90 dBA as measured 50 feet from any stage or sound source from 5:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, July 23 and Sunday, July 24, 2016 and must not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source from 10:01 p.m. until midnight on Saturday, July 23, 2016. 3) The applicant will provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices must be turned off no later than midnight Saturday, July 23, 2016 and 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 24, 2016. 5) The Asian Economic Development Association must maintain a copy of the approved sound level variance at the event location and have it available for review by the City of Saint Paul Police or inspection personnel.

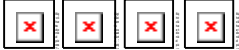
