- 1. Basement Bathroom SPLC 34.11, MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MSPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition. The toilet was loose to the floor.
- 2. Basement SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code.

 -There was a missing smoke detector in the basement.

- 3. First floor Hallway SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code.

 -There was an empty smoke detector bracket next to a functioning smoke/CO detector.
- 4. Furnace Intake UMC 2103 All equipment, appurtenances, devices, and piping must be installed in a workmanlike manner.-The intake pipe on the furnace was cut off at the top of the furnace. Have a contractor install the intake pipe per manufacturers specifications.
- 5. Garage/Greenhouse SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.-
- 6. Garage/Shed/Gazebo SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.-
- 7. North bedroom Smoke detector SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code. -The smoke detector in the bedroom would not sound.
- 8. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 9. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
