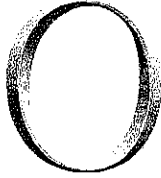

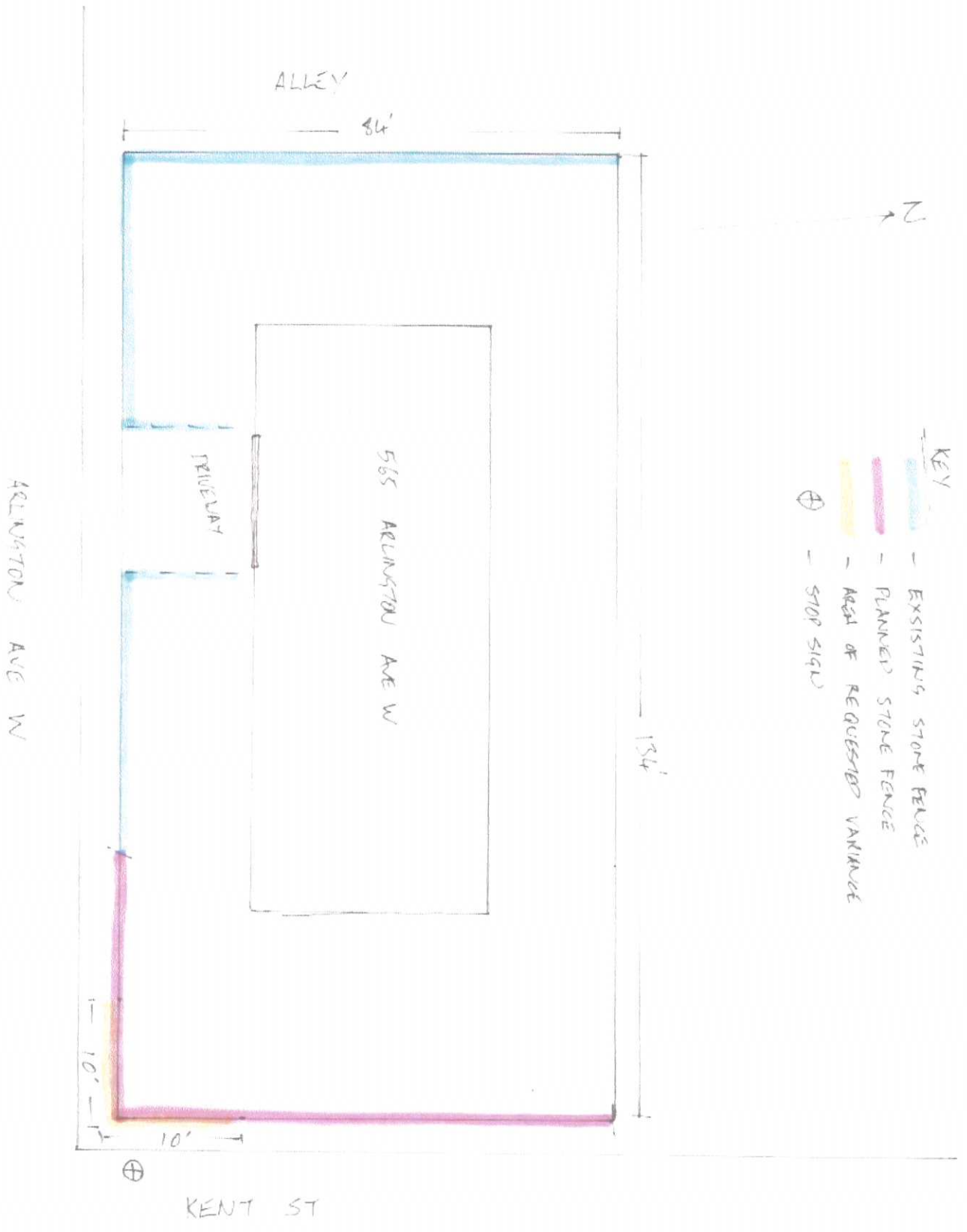
OWEN MASONRY

Owen Masonry requests a fence height variance to allow 4' instead of 2' (per fence requirements sec. 33.07 B) at the corner of Kent Street and Arlington Avenue West.

- 1) **Site Conditions.** The existing property grade level at the corner is 1' 8" above sidewalk level. A 2' fence would only extend 4" above yard grade.
- 2) **Terrain Conditions.** The wall is to the right of a driver turning right onto Arlington Ave W., the view of oncoming traffic is to the left. When turning left, the view to the right is already somewhat obstructed by large vehicles frequently parked on Arlington Ave W.
- 3) **Nuisance Conditions.** One of the reasons for inclosing the yard is to prevent people and pets from walking across the corners of the yard. This has caused considerable distress to the owner who is an avid gardener. The yard is currently designated as a monarch butterfly way station. The enclosure and security of the yard is important to the owner as she has two small children and her eyesight is compromised by a brain tumor.
