Description of Variance:

Location: Start at Shepard Road at Walnut Street and Finish at Shepard Road just West of Ontario Street

Noise Source: Podium Sports Marketing, RBC Minnesota Half Marathon has applied for a sound level variance, at no specified sound level limit, in order to present a brief announcement and National Anthem at Shepard Road at Walnut Street for the Event Start and amplified music and announcements at Shepard Road just West of Ontario Street for the Event Finish. The RBC MN Half Marathon is to be held on Saturday, August 6, 2016, with a request for no specified sound level limit, from 6:45 a.m. until 12:00 noon, with a pre-event sound check at 6:35 a.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 6:45 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 6:45 a.m. for the Event on Saturday, August 6, 2016. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for music and/or announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 12:00 p.m. on the date of the event.
