Amplified sound on Target Stage must end at 10:00 p.m., per Parks Department end time Policy. 3) Pub Stage (Tent): All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices used in conjunction with the event must not exceed 95 dBA at the sound mix or 50 feet from stage, whichever is the shorter distance.
