#### A re-inspection will be made on July 25, 2016 at 11:00am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. EXTERIOR 1706 SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.-Window glass is cracked.
- 2. INTERIOR 1706 SPC 4715.0400 Provide approved plumbing materials for water, waste, and vent.-Flexible tubing is being used under the sink. Piping needs to have a smooth interior finish.
- 3. INTERIOR 1708 #1 NEC 408.4 Circuit Directory Every electrical circuit shall be legibly identified as to its clear, evident, and specific purpose or use.-Bathroom panel needs to be labeled.

- 4. INTERIOR 1708 #2 MSMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Also, duct tape in not an approved heating equipment material.
- 5. INTERIOR 1708 #3 SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.
- -Kitchen and bathroom walls have bubbling/peeling paint.
- 6. INTERIOR 1708 #3 SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Kitchen ceiling appears to have water damage and is peeling.
