Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on July 8, 2016. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A re-inspection will be made on July 15, 2016 at 2:00 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Exterior - MSFC 304.1 - Remove excessive combustible storage and/or vegetation from exterior property areas.-
Between house and garage.
Behind garage at alley.
2. Interior - Basement - MSFC 605.1 -Provide a grounding jumper around the water meter.-
3. Interior - Bathrooms-see comments - MSFC 605.1 - Repair or replace damaged electrical appliance wiring. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
Lower unit: Bathroom GFCI tests 'Hot and Neutral Reversed.'
Upper unit Bathroom GFCI tests 'Open Ground.'
4. Interior - Upper Unit - SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) - Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-
Ceiling in living room shows water damage.
Ceiling in dining room shows water damage.
Ceiling in northeast sleeping room shows water damage.
