Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on May 23, 2016. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on July 26, 2016 at 10:00 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. 506A THROUGHOUT SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.
  - -Replace the broken glass on the windows.
- 2. 506B BOTH FURNACES MN Rules 1300.0180, SPLC 33.03 Immediately discontinue use of unsafe heating appliance until repaired or replaced by a licensed contractor. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Red tags may not be removed except by fire department inspector.
  - -Both furnaces in unit 506B have been installed without the required permits. The furnace installation is not code compliant. Have a licensed contractor obtain and final all necessary permits.

- 3. 506B MSFC 703 Repair and maintain the required fire resistive construction with approved materials and methods. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
  - -Unit 506B does not have the proper required separation from unit 506A and the commercial tenant space.
- 4. TWIN CITIES CHIROPRACTIC MAIN EXIT MSFC 1010.1, 1003.3.1.8 Post a sign stating 'THIS DOOR MUST REMAIN UNLOCKED WHEN BUILDING IS OCCUPIED' at main exits with interior key locks. The minimum stroke of the letter must be 1 inch high with a contrasting background.
- 5. HOT WATER HEATER SPLC 33.03 Permits when required. Building and general construction. No person shall construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish or change the occupancy of a building or structure without first obtaining a building permit from the building official.
  - -The hot water heater was installed without the required permit(s), Have a licensed contractor obtain and final the necessary permit(s).
