Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on July 11, 2016, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

A re-inspection will be made on July 29, 2016 at 9:30 AM or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Back of House SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Repair, replace or remove the collapse fence in the back yard.
 - 7/11/16 There are still sections of the fence in disrepair.
- 2. Exterior Back of House SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.-The wrong type of handrail has been installed.

- 3. Exterior Parking Space SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.

 - Since the garage has been demolished, the zoning law requires that every property has one (1) off-street parking available. If there are any questions, please call DSI and speak to someone in the zoning department.
- 4. MSBC -Section 105.1 Permits Required. Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building official and obtain the required permit. Work being done requires a permit. Ensure that all the proper permits have been obtained for the exterior work. Please contact DSI if you have any questions at 651-266-8989.
- 5. SPLC 40.06 Suspension, revocation and denial. (A) Grounds for revocation. The fire code official may, in writing, issue a notice to the owner(s) and know interested parties of the city's suspension or revocation of a fire certificate of occupancy issued under the provisions of this code, or deny an application, therefor:
 (3) If it is found upon inspection of the fire code official that the building or occupancy is in violation of provisions of this or other applicable safety codes, ordinances, rules and
 - The Certificate of Occupancy has been revoked due to long-term non-compliance. The owner has failed to provide site-plans, obtain and final permit(s) and provided a parking surface for the property.
- 6. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
