Sound Level Variance Whole Foods Market – Block Party

Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

The original notice for this event, which you should have already received, indicated the date was Monday, September 19, 2016. The correct date is **Saturday, September 10, 2016**. All other information is the same.

Description of Variance:

Location: Dayton Avenue between Snelling Ave and Saratoga Street North

Noise Source: Whole Foods Market has applied for a sound level variance, at a requested sound level limit of 85 dBA at 50 feet, in order to provide live amplified music outdoors on Dayton Avenue between Snelling Avenue and Saratoga Street North on Saturday, September 10, 2016 from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 4:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 4:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. for live amplified music outdoors on September 10, 2016. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for amplified music and/or announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 9:00 p.m. on September 10, 2016.
