

## To whom it may concern:

I am the property owner at 726 Randolph Avenue, Saint Paul, MN 55102. I have received a notice from the city that Shannon Ingham of 4360 France Avenue #6 in Minneapolis is planning on building a "tiny" house on the empty lot at 492 Bay Street in Saint Paul (an empty lot at the corner of Bay and Randolph Ave). It is adjacent to my 4 bedroom house.

I am completely opposed to any building on this lot for the following reasons:

- 1. The lot is too small to fit a family sized house within existing building codes. He is demanding 3 variances to build his tiny house.
- 2. The natural flow the of the neighborhood is to have corner houses facing the major thoroughfare (Randolph). His corner house, would not face Randolph.
- 3. The property owner said he would have to cut back my trees, which currently provide the only shade for the entire corner, and cool my yard and my house. My trees and the root systems will not survive. These are mature and beautiful trees which provide shade and are home to squirrels, and birds.
- 4. My house was built in 1900 and sits on a limestone foundation which has had structural issues. I have great concerns which have been validated by commercial and residential builders, that any ground disturbances on that lot could cause my foundation to buckle.
- 5. I have had water in my basement and the water drainage displaced by building anything on that lot would cause more foundation issues at my house. A replacement foundation and drainage system would cost me over \$60,000.
- 6. He Illegally, and without a permit, built a "tool shed" at the back of his property, which is also currently in violation of building codes. (A) He should not have built anything without providing notice to neighbors. (B) He cannot build anything without a primary structure (house), (C) the "tool shed" is a foot too close to my property line (which puts it directly in line with the gutter downspout from neighbors house at 496 Bay.
- 7. Off street parking on Bay Street is already at a premium with Bay Street Grill customers parking on Bay. We have visitors to 726 Randolph Avenue that currently park on Bay Street. This proposal would increase traffic congestion, and would likely cost Bay Street Grill several thousands of dollars in lost revenue annually. I hope the city has notified Bay Street Grill of this proposal, which would further hurt small established neighborhood businesses in Saint Paul.

- 8. The sales appeal and real property value of my property will be negatively impacted. I have real estate agents that have verified this.
- 9. This neighborhood needs to keep all the green space that it can. The prior owner of the small lot used it as an inner city garden space, and she would kindly provide garden space to neighbors and encouraged gardening which promoted the green space.

Lastly, I work out of town. I received this notice on June 24th (I was on vacation June 16 - 23) for the hearing that is scheduled for July 6th (right after the long July 4th weekend). Please let me know if I need to provide additional documentation or gather additional feedback from other neighbors along Bay that will be impacted due to loss of parking.

Please call me and let me know what I can do to prevent this building from occurring.
