## PROPOSED CHANGE TO ALLOWABLE LIQUOR STORE HOURS

Currently the City of Saint Paul requires off-sale liquor purchases to end at 8:00 p.m. Monday-Thursday and 10:00 p.m. Friday and Saturday. Some members of the Saint Paul City Council are exploring amending the allowable hours of liquor off-sale to 10:00 p.m. Monday-Saturday to align with current regulations in surrounding cities.

#### Background

- Prior to 2005, State Law mandated that liquor stores in cities of the first class (Minneapolis, Saint Paul and Duluth) close at 8:00 p.m. Monday-Thursday and 10:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday. All other municipalities were allowed to sell liquor until 10:00 p.m. Monday-Saturday.
- In 2005, that State Law was repealed; Minneapolis and Duluth changed their ordinances the same year to 10:00 p.m. closures Monday- Saturday. Saint Paul did not.

### Liquor in Saint Paul

- As of June 21, 2016 the City of Saint Paul has 50 active off-sale liquor licenses.
- With the exception of Mendota Heights (whose liquor stores close at 9:00 p.m. Monday-Thursday) every other municipality sharing a border with Saint Paul is consistent with a 10:00 p.m. closing time Monday-Saturday.
- Saint Paul has a burgeoning brewery culture. Right now, with the exception of Sundays', breweries can only sell growlers during legal hours for off-sale. So while most breweries are open until 10:00 p.m. Monday-Thursday they cannot sell take-home brews for the last two hours of business, meaning lost revenue for the breweries and frustration and confusion for customers.

### **Proposed Ordinance Amendment**

The proposed ordinance change below would change the allowable liquor store hours in Saint Paul from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Monday-Saturday. The proposed changes to holiday hours are already state law and the amendment would bring city code into compliance.

Sec. 409.07.

(b) Off-sale hours of sale. No off-sale shall be made before 8:00 a.m. or after 8:00 p.m. of any day except off-sale shall be permitted on Friday and Saturday until 10:00 p.m. No off-sale shall be made on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day, December 25, or after 8:00 p.m. on Christmas Eve, December 24. If the sale of liquors is not otherwise prohibited on July 3, the date preceding Thanksgiving Day or on December 31, off-sale may be made until 10:00 p.m.
