Contact a licensed Heating, Ventilation, and Air-Conditioning (HVAC) contractor to evaluate the current ventilation system and provide the inspector verification (balance report) that the ventilation system is providing minimum ventilation rates as per code based upon current square footage, number of occupants, and nail salon stations being utilized. Any deficiencies must be corrected by licensed HVAC contractor under permit.
