#### VACANT BUILDING REGISTRATION NOTICE

#### The premises at **1049 HAGUE AVE**

has been inspected and found to meet the legal definition of a Vacant Building as described in Saint Paul Legislative Code, Chapter 43. You are required by law to register this building with the Department of Safety and Inspections, Vacant Building Division, by filling out and returning the registration form provided with this letter. You are also required to pay the annual Vacant Building Registration Fee of \$2,085.00. The fee is due upon receipt of this letter and must be paid no later than thirty (30) days from the date of this letter, as required in Saint Paul Legislative Code, Chapter 43. If this building is vacant due to a fire, complete the enclosed registration form and return it to this office within 30 days.

Please return the enclosed registration form along with your payment by October 21, 2016.

You may file an appeal to this fee or registration requirements by contacting the City Clerk's Office by calling (651)266-8688. Any appeal of this fee must be made within ten (10) days of the date of this notice.

If the registration fee is not received in this office within 45 days of the date of this letter, the full amount owed will be assessed to, and collected with, the taxes for this property as permitted by Saint Paul Legislative Code Chapter 43.

The Code Enforcement Officer has notified the Building Inspection and Design Section that this property meets the legal definition of a registered vacant building and in accordance with Legislative Code Chapter 33, no permits (except demolition, wrecking and removal permits) will be issued until the requirements of all applicable ordinances are fulfilled.

All catergory 2 and category 3 vacant buildings must be winterized with gas and water services shut off or, alternately, an excess flow gas valve must be installed in the dwelling, within sixty (60) days of the date of this notice.

# WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL IS REQUIRED BEFORE A CATEGORY 2 OR CATEGORY 3 VACANT BUILDING CAN BE OCCUPIED OR SOLD.

- Category 2: Requirements include: 1. register/re-register the building, 2. pay outstanding fee(s), 3. obtain a code compliance report, 4. submit for approval a rehab cost estimate from a licensed contractor and a schedule for completion of all code compliance work, 5. submit proof of financial responsibility acceptable to the City, and 6. obtain Zoning approval of the proposed use.
- **Category** 3: All requirements listed for Category 2 vacant buildings, AND obtain a **Certificate of Occupancy** OR **Certificate of Code Compliance** prior to the sale of the building.

If the use of this building meets the definition of a nonconforming use by the Zoning Code, then the use will lose its nonconforming status 365 days from the date the building was declared vacant.

You must contact the Enforcement officer, Mike Kalis, at 651-266-1929 to find out what must be done before this building can be legally reoccupied.

The Enforcement Officer may declare this building to constitute a Nuisance Building subject to demolition and issue an Order to Abate under authority of Legislative Code Chapter 45. In the event this building is declared a Nuisance Building, subject to demolition, the Enforcement Office will notify all owners and interested parties of the Order to Abate as provided in the Legislative Code Chapter 45.

I am writing to appeal the Revocation of Fire C of O and the Vacant Building Category 2 status of the property located on 1049 Hague Ave, Saint Paul, Minnesota, 55104.

My partner (HG Enterprise LLC) and I bought this property on July  $12^{th}$  2016 from the original owner Marilyn Neeland. She was living at the property when we bought it from her. Due to her circumstances, we let her stay in the property until July  $18^{th}$  2016 to help her move and find a place to live.

Since the original owner was living in the property, she does not need a Fire C of O. We are just currently renovating the property to restore it and we are not renting it out to anyone, so we do not need the Fire C of O as well.

We met the Fire Marshal on September  $16^{th}$  2016 at the property. He saw that we were pulling down the sidings and asked about the permit for it. The siding permit was pulled by Xtreme Construction on that same day and it is recorded with the City.

We are currently renovating this property therefore there may be some construction debris. Ever since we bought the property, we have had it properly secured. Also, we had filled two 40 yard dumpster to keep it clean maintain the lot. We are working to restore this property on a daily basis. All the surrounding neighbors has introduced themselves to us and thanked us for restoring this property.

In summary, we do not need the C of O as of now because we are in the renovation process and the property is not a Category 2 Vacant building because we have it properly secured and well maintained. My partner and I hope that you see the value in our goal to restore this property. Not only will the property gain its value back, but the neighborhood, community and the city will too.
