Your building was inspected on November 7, 2016 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

### A re-inspection will be made on December 5, 2016 at 1:00pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### DEFICIENCY LIST

- INTERIOR BASEMENT MSFC 605.4 Re-locatable power taps shall be of the polarized or grounded type, equipped with overcurrent protection, and shall be listed in accordance with UL 1363. Re-locatable power taps shall be directly connected to a permanently installed receptacle. -Power strip plugged into extension cord.
- INTERIOR BASEMENT MSFC 104.9, 1005.3.2.2 Remove the storage under the 2. stairs or provide and maintain 1 hour fire resistive construction on the storage side of the stairs.-Combustible materials stored underneath the stairs needs to be removed.

- 3. INTERIOR BASEMENT & UPSTAIRS MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 4. INTERIOR MAIN FLOOR SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code.
  -Bathroom door has a hole in it.
- 5. INTERIOR MAIN FLOOR & UPSTAIRS MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multiplug adapters.-Bedrooms
- 6. INTERIOR UPSTAIRS SPLC 34.13 (1) Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling height of 7 feet over 1/2 the floor area.-Maximum ceiling height is 6' 8".
