Exception to General Hours of Operation Application


Minnesota Children's Museum

Reason for Request:

The Minnesota Children's Museum requests a temporary exception to Skyway ordinance 140:11 for the following reason:

- As part of the Museum's current Capital Expansion Project that is underway, the Museum will close temporarily to the public starting December 5th 2016 through March 31, 2017.
- We would like to close the skyway on the weekends during that time period.
- Primary use of the skyway is for those heading to the Museum: Visitors, staff and volunteers as well as construction team members during the project.
- Weekend use is almost exclusively Museum Visitors, staff and volunteers.
- On weekends during closure we will not have staff, visitors, construction or volunteers on site.
- The Skyway access terminates at the Minnesota Children's Museum and does not directly connect to any other business. Access to Wabasha street businesses is available through Wells Fargo Place.
- The Museum Skyway does not provide direct access to any city housing or parking.
- The Museum's Skyway allows direct access to the Museum, Security personnel are required onsite at all times the Skyway is open.
- During closure the Museum is not generating admissions revenue and is reducing staffing and operating costs accordingly. Having to staff on weekends only to provide security based upon scant to no use of the skyway by the general public traffic would be burdensome and we would prefer to utilize donor dollars in more critical ways.


Based upon this reason the Minnesota Children's Museum requests a temporary exception to weekend hours of this skyway
